ABOUT

Quin Cheung is a Canadian ceramic artist whose work celebrates the quiet beauty of everyday rituals through thoughtfully crafted functional pottery. Working from her Calgary studio under the name Quinspired, Cheung creates timeless vessels that balance refined minimalism with warmth, inviting moments of connection around the table and within the home. Each piece is designed to be both beautiful and purposeful, encouraging a slower, more intentional way of living through objects made to be used and cherished.

Working in small batches, Cheung hand-throws, trims, glazes, and fires every piece herself, allowing the natural qualities of clay, form, and texture to guide the finished work. Her restrained aesthetic emphasizes clean silhouettes, tactile surfaces, and understated elegance, resulting in ceramics that celebrate craftsmanship as much as function. Whether creating vessels for daily use or sculptural forms, her practice reflects a belief that thoughtfully made objects have the power to enrich everyday experiences.

Cheung's work has received national recognition through publications, awards, and gallery representation, including the Made in Alberta Award for Craft and features in Studio Magazine, House & Home, and Western Living. Through her commitment to craftsmanship, generosity, and intentional design, she continues to create ceramics that bring together beauty, utility, and a deep appreciation for the art of living well.
