ABOUT

Mitchell Fenton is a Canadian landscape painter whose work celebrates the enduring beauty and spirit of the natural world. Working primarily in oil, Fenton paints en plein air across Canada's diverse landscapes, from the Rocky Mountains and prairies to the forests and coastlines. His portable painting practice allows him to immerse himself in remote environments, capturing the atmosphere, light, and character of each place before developing select studies into larger studio paintings.

Influenced by Canada's rich tradition of landscape painting, Fenton's work reflects both careful observation and a deep emotional connection to the land. His compositions balance vibrant colour, expressive brushwork, and a refined sense of light to create paintings that feel both timeless and deeply personal. Whether depicting expansive mountain vistas or quiet moments along a shoreline, his paintings invite viewers to experience the calm, wonder, and nostalgia found within Canada's wilderness.

Fenton's work has been exhibited extensively across Canada and is held in numerous private and corporate collections. Through his thoughtful approach to painting, he continues to celebrate the landscapes that have shaped Canada's artistic identity while offering a contemporary perspective on the places that inspire him most.
