ABOUT

Born and raised in Kitchener, Ontario, Pam Weber is a contemporary Canadian painter whose work celebrates the joy, warmth, and quiet wonder found in everyday life. Now living and working in Calgary, Alberta, Weber creates vibrant acrylic paintings that transform familiar landscapes, neighbourhoods, interiors, and wildlife into imaginative worlds filled with colour, rhythm, and possibility. Rooted in personal experience yet open to interpretation, her work invites viewers to discover their own stories within each composition.

Working primarily in acrylic, Weber combines bold design, expressive colour, and richly layered surfaces to create paintings that balance structure with spontaneity. Drawing on her background in printmaking and graphic arts, she carefully builds each composition through pattern, shape, and texture, resulting in a distinctive visual language that is both playful and sophisticated. Whether depicting peaceful landscapes, lively streetscapes, or whimsical interiors, her paintings evoke a sense of optimism while encouraging moments of reflection and delight.

A graduate of the University of Guelph, Weber has enjoyed a distinguished career spanning more than four decades. An active member of the Alberta Society of Artists and an Associate Member of the Federation of Canadian Artists, her work has been exhibited throughout Canada and is held in numerous private, corporate, and public collections. Through her luminous palette and imaginative perspective, Weber continues to create paintings that celebrate community, connection, and the enduring beauty of the everyday.
