About the Artist:

Shelley Mansel has been painting the landscape for over 20 years. She attended UCFV in British Columbia for 2 years in the art diploma program, and continued her studies with 3 years in the BFA program at NSCAD in Halifax, Nova Scotia. Mansel had shown in solo, two person, and group exhibitions in Halifax, Toronto, Vancouver, Whistler, and Maine throughout her professional art career. Mansel's works have been reviewed in print and online in Halifax and Toronto, and her work has been published in House&Home magazine and on HGTV. She has self published two books and is included in the publication, "from Land and Sea: Nova Scotia's Contemporary Landscape Artists". Shelley was chosen as a marquee artist for CBC's Sharing the View calendar 2012.

Mansel's work are held in private collections in Canada, Germany, USA, France, and in permanent collections included St. Mary's University Halifax and UBC Vancouver. She has received three NS Creation Grants and a Presentation Grant and has been part of the selection committee for the Nova Scotia Culture Division/Grants to Individuals Program. She was the first visiting Artist-in-Residence at the Annex Art residency in Castine, Maine and has returned several times as a visiting artist to the program.

She currently lives and works in her home studio in rural Nova Scotia.
