Cheryl Peddie is a contemporary Canadian painter whose work celebrates the beauty of everyday places through a masterful exploration of light, atmosphere, and design. Living and working in Calgary, Alberta, Peddie creates luminous oil paintings inspired by Alberta's landscapes, vibrant urban neighbourhoods, and intimate interior spaces. Whether capturing the warmth of a bustling café, the quiet charm of a mountain trail, or the changing character of a familiar street, her work transforms ordinary moments into enduring visual experiences.

Working primarily in oil, Peddie combines years of experience as a graphic designer with a deep commitment to painting from life. Since embracing plein air painting in 2014, she has developed a practice rooted in direct observation, allowing each work to reflect the unique qualities of changing light, weather, and season. Her expressive brushwork, thoughtful compositions, and rich colour harmonies evoke both a strong sense of place and the emotional connection we form with the landscapes and communities around us.

A full-time artist for more than three decades, Peddie has exhibited throughout Western Canada and has earned recognition through numerous juried exhibitions and plein air competitions. Her paintings are held in corporate and commissioned collections across Alberta, reflecting a practice that continues to resonate with collectors through its optimism, authenticity, and celebration of everyday beauty.
