ABOUT

Paige Ring is a contemporary Canadian abstract painter whose work explores the emotional power of colour, texture, and gesture through a refined minimalist aesthetic. Living and working in Toronto, Ontario, Ring creates richly layered abstract paintings that balance spontaneity with intention, inviting viewers to discover their own narratives within each composition. Inspired by the beauty found in simplicity, her work transforms bold mark-making, organic forms, and luminous colour into contemplative spaces that encourage curiosity, reflection, and emotional connection.

Before pursuing fine art full-time, Ring built a successful career in fashion design and creative direction, experiences that continue to inform her approach to composition, materiality, and visual storytelling. Working primarily with acrylic, ink, collage, and mixed media, she develops richly textured surfaces using palette knives, squeegees, and unconventional tools, creating paintings that reveal new details with prolonged viewing. Her intuitive process embraces both structure and chance, celebrating abstraction's ability to evoke deeply personal responses.

Today, Ring is represented by galleries across Canada and has established an international collector base through her distinctive contemporary practice. Her work has been exhibited throughout Ontario and Alberta and is held in private collections across Canada, the United States, Europe, and South America. Through her thoughtful exploration of colour, movement, and form, Ring continues to create paintings that bring energy, balance, and quiet optimism to contemporary interiors.
